

**2010 La Peira Coteaux du Languedoc les  
Obriers Terrasses du Larzac**

The 2010 Coteaux du Languedoc Terrasses du Larzac Les Obriers gives up ample black cherry, mineral, pepper and wild herbs to go with a medium-bodied, layered and yet elegant overall profile. Aging beautifully and still youthful and vibrant, it will have another 4-5 years of longevity.

One of reference point producers in the Languedoc, and in my view, easily one of the top estates in all of France, La Peira en Damaisela was created in 2004 by Australian composer Rob Dougan, with the talented Jeremie Depierre making the wines. Covering 11 hectares of gravelly, rocky soils in the Terrasses du Larzac region, they produce a single white, based on Roussanne and Viognier, and four red cuvees; the Cinsault/Carignan-driven Les Obriers; the Grenache heavy (includes 25% Syrah and smaller parts Mourvedre, Cinsault and Carignan)
